Notes inserées par M. Cauchy dans les Comptes
Rendus de deux des séances précédentes.*

Session of 8 August 1853

“There is found in the *Comptes rendus* of the sessions of 18 and 25 July last, an interview of matters which has led many persons to ask me why I did not respond to the *second* communication of Mr. Cauchy, which has appeared in the *Compte rendu* of the 25th. As this *second* communication has not existed; as I have only to maintain my response inserted into the *Compte rendu* of the session of the 18th, I would desire that it was well explicated how the Memoir of Mr. Cauchy, communicated in this session, has been lastly divided into two publications. The one, which contains precisely the analytic part that our fellow-member scholar had not developed in the session, has been placed in the *Compte rendu* of the 18th. The other, which contains that which had been read the 18th, and to which especially is applied my response, has been inserted only in the *Compte rendu* of the 25th. It seemed to me useful to state clearly that my response, although published previously, had been made immediately after the reading of the set of the Memoir.

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
